The Earth Charter is “a declaration of fundamental principles for building a just, sustainable and peaceful global society in the 21st Century.” (Earth Charter Initiative 2000: Introduction). The Charter constitutes a framework of ethical principles for a sustainable global society. It is the product of a decade long cross-cultural dialogue. What is of particular significance is The Earth Charter is the product of global civil society. The Charter has been endorsed by the General Assembly of the United Nations and adopted by UNESCO as its educational framework for the Decade of Sustainable Development.
